Healthcare seeks remedies after Scott decides to revive a bill Things got ugly Wednesday after Gov. Rick Scott announced he would resurrect a bill that would curtail some of the key provisions of the Affordable Care Act and has created a contentious reaction from the business community. In a letter sent to Senate President Joe Negron and House Speaker Richard Corcoran, Scott said he would offer an amendment to a budget bill in the upcoming legislative session that would repeal parts of the state's Affordable Care Act, also known as Obamacare. That law provided tax credits for people who purchased private health insurance. The letter from Scott, a Republican, also calls on the Legislature to change the law that governs the Health Insurance Exchange, which is overseen by the state and is central to the Affordable Care Act. State businesses, which have to deal with the law as it is, along with thousands of Florida residents, say that the law is flawed and full of potential problems. One of the biggest questions, for example, is the rate that private insurance providers are allowed to charge people who get coverage through the exchange. The Affordable Care Act set a limit for these companies at a rate of 58 percent, and it's not clear whether the rate can be reduced. There's also concern that the law could allow for insurance providers to refuse to cover people with pre-existing conditions. And individuals who buy insurance via the exchange could be subject to unfair insurance mandates. Scott and many other lawmakers have said the law needs to be repealed, and Scott has previously threatened to use his executive power to allow the state to seek a repeal of the Affordable Care Act. Negron and Corcoran immediately slammed the plan, calling the move "unacceptable," "disgraceful," and "immoral." Corcoran said Scott had "been on a national tour" touting the law and said this marked a reversal for the governor. 82157476af
